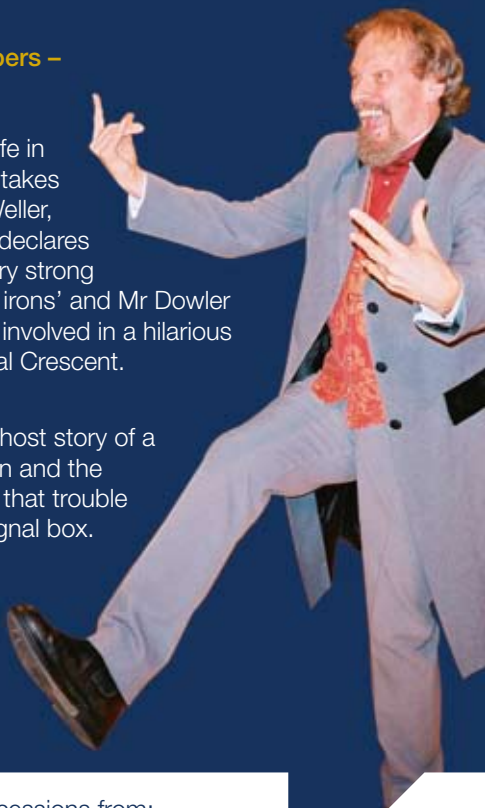
Charles Dickens is brought vividly to life in this one-man double-bill by Doc Watson on the 200th anniversary of Dickens' birth.
